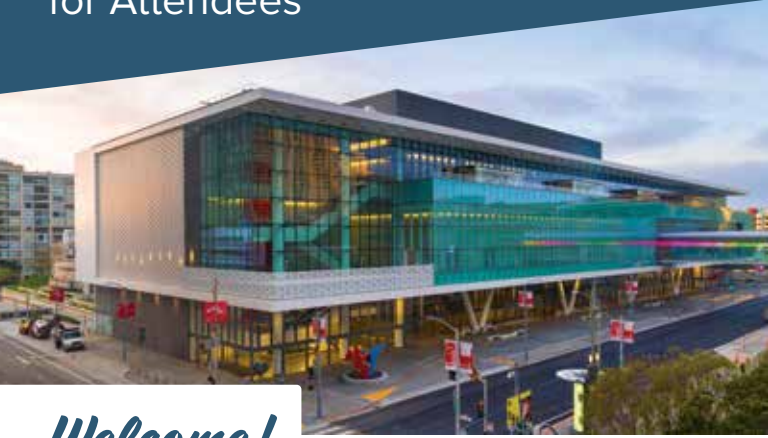


# SAFETY TIPS

Follow the below tips to keep safe on San Francisco's busy streets.

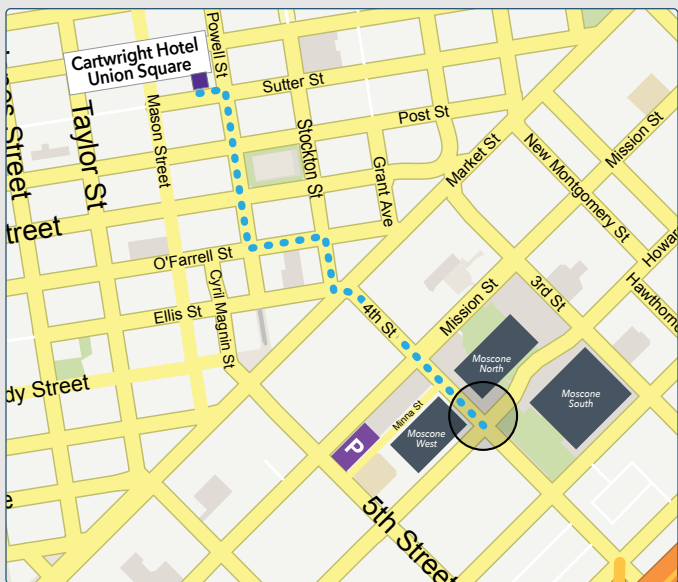
- Remove your attendee badge and put it away, or recycle it.
